Five Unexcused Tardies in One Class: • Teacher Implements Classroom Consequences; and/or, • Teacher Meets with Student to Problem-Solve; and, • Teacher Calls Home	10 Total Tardies Based on Raptor/Campus Reports: • Lunch Detention; and, • Parent Notification	Second Set of 10 Total Tardies Based on Raptor/Campus Reports: • Lunch Detention; and, • Parent Notification	Third Set of 10 Total Tardies Based on Raptor/Campus Reports:	Following Three Sets of 10 Tardy Concerns, All Subsequent Tardies Will Monitored and Interventions Will Be Implemented for Every 10 Additional Tardies Based on Raptor/Campus Reports: In-School Suspension; Family Notification; Referral to grade-level admin; Family Conference to Review Plan for Improvement
